RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR SWIM ACTIVITIES

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between _____, as parent(s) and legal guardian(s) (hereinafter known as "Parent") of the minor child/children listed below that will be participating in swim activities, and the Churchill Village South Homeowners Association, Inc., its members, owners, directors, officers, agents, employees, managers, swim team, swim team coaches and personnel, and representatives (hereinafter collectively known as "the Association"), on this _____ day of _____, 2018.

Permission and Release

The above named Parent does hereby authorize and permit the below named minor child/children to participate in the Swim Team activities conducted by the Association. In consideration for the privilege of participation in said activities, the Parent does hereby, on behalf of his/her child/children release, indemnify, and hold harmless the Association from all liability for damages and injuries of any kind to the person and property of the Parent's child/children. This release of liability shall pertain to injuries and losses occurring on or off the Association premises, during, before or because of swim team practice, training, instruction, travel, competition or related activities, and/or swim meets in the Association's designated swimming pools and its environs, and travel to swim meets and alternate practice locations. This release is intended to be as broad as permitted under the laws of Maryland.

Assumption of the Risk

The Parent does hereby acknowledge that there are certain risks inherent in the very nature of swim team activities, including the risk of bodily injury and death. It is understood that such risks include, but are not limited to, impact or contact with natural or man-made objects, equipment, chemicals, substances or other persons. It is further acknowledged that injury may arise from known or unknown health problems and from foreseeable and unforeseeable causes and include, but are not limited to, sprains and bruises, major injuries such as broken bones, concussions, etc.

The Parent represents and warrants that his/her child/children is/are in proper health and physical condition to participate in swim activities. The Parent agrees that in allowing their child/children to participate in swim activities, their child/children will comply with all rules and safety requirements.

The Parent further acknowledges that they are aware that they must have their own insurance to cover medical expenses or otherwise assume all financial responsibility in the event of injury to their child/children. It is solely a decision of the Parent whether to obtain such insurance.

Having fully considered the risks, the Parent does hereby assume any and all risk involved in the swim team participation and does hereby release the Association and its members, owners, directors, officers, agents, employees, managers, swim team, swim team coaches and personnel, and representatives from any and all liability for injury or loss as herein described, and any and all damages, liability, and causes of action, including costs and attorney's fees, arising from or related in any way to the child/children's participation in swim team activities.
